



Dear Volunteer,

Thank you for inquiring about the Hillsborough Literacy Council's tutor training. Enclosed you will find some information about our program and the materials you must submit in order to register for one of our training sessions.

Founded in 1986, Hillsborough Literacy Council Inc. (HLC) is a non-profit organization affiliated with the Tampa-Hillsborough County Public Library System. We provide free one-on-one tutoring in reading and writing to adult non-readers and individual or small group English instruction to speakers of other languages.

Potential tutors in Adult Basic Literacy and ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) programs must:

- Be 18 years of age
- Have a high school diploma or GED certificate
- Have a Hillsborough County Public Library card
- Have transportation
- Be willing to make a one-year commitment to the program
- Complete tutor training workshops
- Agree to tutor once or twice per week

ESOL tutors do not need to speak another language. In fact, it is best that the tutor does not speak the student's native language. This way, we can guarantee a "full immersion" situation; the student and tutor will be forced to use English to communicate.

You may register for one of our upcoming tutor training workshops by submitting the registration form. Registration is required as space is limited. When you complete the workshop, you will be assigned a student according to your schedule and preferred tutoring location. Tutoring takes place in libraries throughout the county, as well as other approved locations. After meeting with a student for at least two weeks, you should attend the Supplemental Resources Workshop as the second part of your training. At that time you will receive a certificate of training. Also, tutors are encouraged to participate in three tutor meetings per year.

Tutoring is a big commitment and one you should consider carefully before registering for a class; however our volunteers have found it to be an immensely rewarding experience. 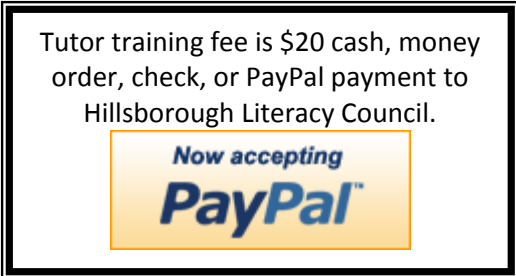
