The Hillsborough Literacy Council Board of Directors has voted to maintain the current slate of officers in their positions through 2022.

Conversation Corners Continue Online

Due to the unknown effects of Covid heading into 2022, and to avoid disruption of services should county facilities be closed to the public, the Hillsborough Literacy Council Board of Directors has voted to continue Conversation Corners in virtual format only for the time being. Should things change, we will look for in-library conversation leaders.

Tutor Training Update

Tutor training will resume in December 2020, with new student and tutor matching resuming in early 2022. New volunteers will begin their individual training online, and will attend live sessions for either online tutoring or in-library tutoring early in 2022. We have not trained in-library tutors since 2019.



Laundry Cares Program

The HLC has been in discussions with the Laundry Cares program to sponsor a literacy space in a local laundromat. The Literacy Coordinator, Eric Hughes, visited one such location, Wash Zone Laundry, 5235 S. Dale Mabry Hwy, Tampa. This location is a new facility that incorporated youth literacy in the design of the facility. They offer free use of books, tablets, a play area, a patio, and snacks. We encourage you to have a look for yourself as to what facilities can be like when they are designed with the community in mind.
